**WORTHINGTON FARMERS MARKET
RULES AND REGULATIONS**

1. Farmers are to sell what they produce. The exception is to occasionally sell "the neighbor's" produce. All produce must be grown in Ohio. We allow homemade baked goods, cheeses, jams, and crafts etc. (provided the processed foods have met all the State and Local regulations).
2. One vehicle is allowed for delivery of goods to the market. Only one vehicle can be parked at the market site. The Market Master will decide which vehicles can be parked at the site and which must be parked elsewhere.
3. Tables and stands used to display and sell the goods are to be provided by the vendor. The tables must be set so that pedestrian traffic is not impeded.
4. The Market Master will assign vendors a place. **The size of the booth is 8 x 8 feet. Table should be no larger than 8' long.** An assigned place is for the season.
5. **** Vendors should be in place 30 minutes before start of the market begins. If a vendor is not in place by 9:30 AM the Market Masters reserve the right to place someone in your spot unless you have notified the Market Masters in advance that you will not be at the Market on Time. We also reserve the right to place another vendor in your spot should you not be using your spot on a specific date. Please note change in conditions in this regulations. ****
6. Vendors must have signs on their tables identifying their farm or business. These signs must not intrude into walkway. Vendors are to set their own prices.
7. Vendors must carry or have a wheel cart or dolly to transport their supplies, product, signs, etc. to their booth. **PLEASE DO NOT DRAG ANYTHING ACROSS THE FLOOR.**
8. No loud radios or shouting of prices.
9. Vendors are to clean their areas: remove all produce, containers, signs, and messes at the end of the day or when they leave.
10. All vendors must have **Liability Insurance** to cover their risks at the market.
11. **All vendors are to notify the Market Master or Co-Market Master the night before a market day if they are unable to attend the market.**
12. Vendors are encouraged to assist the Market Master in promoting the market.
13. Grievances or problems are to be directed to the Market Master for resolution.
14. It is the Vendor's responsibility to obtain all the licenses and permits, and to pay the fees required by local and State governments. This includes the vendor's license for good sold for which a sales tax must be collected.
15. Scales should be capable of approval by the Columbus Division of Weights and Measures (614) 645-7397.
16. Vendors must comply with all laws, ordinances, and regulations of the United States, State of Ohio, and Worthington (which uses the City of Columbus Health Department regulations and inspectors).
